#### Experiencing National Cherry Blossom Festival

The National Park Service and our partner, National Cherry Blossom Festival, Inc. offer daily events and activities from March 19 to April 3 in the Tidal Basin Parking Lot. This area is located in the heart of the beautiful Cherry Trees. The Tidal Basin is a man-made inlet adjacent to the Potomac River in Washington, DC. It was created in the late 19th century as part of West Potomac Park to provide recreational space and as a means for draining the Washington Channel after high tide. The Jefferson Memorial, honoring our third President, sits on the south bank of the Tidal Basin. Visitors are drawn to the area because of its beauty, especially during cherry blossom season in late March and early April. Each year people come from across the nation to welcome spring and celebrate the National Cherry Blossom Festival.
