

ONLINE TRAINING NOW AVAILABLE!

LGRMS is continuing to offer Online Training at no cost to ACCG & GMA Risk Management Fund members. ACCG and GMA members completed 2174 online courses through the pilot program in 2010. The 2011 course offerings have been split between Workers Compensation and Liability courses. ACCG & GMA Risk Management Fund member employees can access the courses available based on which fund the member currently purchases their insurance coverage through. This innovative method of training is being offered as a supplement to the regional and onsite training LGRMS currently provides.

Go to our website, lgrms.com, and click on the Online Training box on the lower left side. Click on the Account button to start the process to set up an account with our partner, LocalGovU. If any help is needed either when setting up an account or accessing a specific training session, LocalGovU can be contacted using the phone number listed on the site. LocalGovU support is available between 9 AM and 6 PM.

Once a member account has been set up employees will be able to select a training session from the available course list and use this online training opportunity on a 24/7 basis from any computer with internet access. Once an employee completes a course a certificate can be printed off showing completion. Some of the training could be eligible for continuing education credits in certain professions and for Georgia POST Credit for Law Enforcement Agencies. Check with your professional association to find out if the course is eligible. We have posted a separate article on POST credit in this edition of the Risk Connection.
