WOODBINE, GEORGIA – April 25, 2016 – Spaceport Camden has partnered with Startup NASA's SPACE RACE in order to launch the next generation of innovators and entrepreneurs. Spaceport Camden Project Leader, Steve Howard, will serve as a judge in the SPACE RACE competition where student-based teams aim to commercialize promising NASA inventions through a startup challenge. Entries are being accepted until May 1st and judging will occur in early September.

"I am excited to represent Spaceport Camden as a judge for Startup NASA's SPACE RACE," said Mr. Howard. "These students are our future. The technologies they commercialize and the companies they found will propel humanity forward beyond the edge of what's currently possible.
