Attorneys will be there to discuss workers compensation procedures with audience participation. Attorneys who represent local governments in Work Comp litigation and court appearances before the Administrative Law Judges, will discuss how the workers compensation system is set up and the employer's satutory requirement when filing a workers compensation claim and what they can do to avoid litigation on workers compensation claims.

Six key elements of a safety program that will assist in preventing injury and illness to employees in the workplace will be discussed in the Loss Control segment of the workshop. It's about protecting the public entity's most valuable asset: its workers. By protecting the employees' well-being, the entity reduces the amount of money paid out in health insurance benefits, workers' compensation benefits, and the cost of wages for temporary help.
