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PROJECT DESCRIPTION



This school provides for instructional space for 1300 students and is to house pre-K through eighth grade with approximately 800 students in the pre-K through 5 and approximately 500 students in 6th through 8th. The goal of the project from an academic standpoint is to allow the students to attend school for a minimum of nine years without having to change their school environment, teachers, or administrative team. The schools also incorporate 12 separate learning centers within each school. Each Learning Center contains approximately 5 classrooms that are centered around a common area. The learning centers are grouped together in groups of four, grades pre-K -2, 3rd to 5th, and 6th to 8th. The building design also provides for the isolation of the academic areas from the assembly areas to allow for community use of the assembly spaces without having to access the academic spaces. The city of Hampton was also a partner in the project and it was designed to accommodate to be a possible shelter as well to the Red Cross's standards.
