The Fay Miller Education Leadership Eagle Institute Award is made annually to an ASBO MD&DC member in recognition of Fay's exemplary service to education. The scholarship award covers Institute registration, hotel accommodations, and all conference meals and travel costs – a value in excess of \$2,000.

THE BRICE & SHIRLEY PHILLIPS BEST PRACTICE AWARD

Brice and Shirley Phillips started with a humble "crab shack" in Ocean City in 1956. Three generations later, their take-out shack has grown to encompass multiple restaurants, a network of franchises, and an international seafood processing industry. Of the many life lessons they have handed down, the cornerstone of each was based on character, honesty and integrity. It was through their hard work and attention to details, knowing there was always room for opportunity and improvement, that they were able to take a family business from Hooper's Island to an international industry. The Phillips were a strong supporter of ASBO and its ideals and this award honors their commitment to excellence and innovation.

The Phillips Best Practice Award is presented each year to an innovative school business idea that fosters effective and efficient use of public monies spent on education.

Paul Bell was the Purchasing Director for Howard County Public Schools, and President of ASBO MD&DC in 1993-1994. His dedication to his family, job, and staff, as well as the schools he supported and his commitment to ASBO MD&DC have made an enduring impression on those who knew him.

THE DWIGHT J. JACOBUS SCHOLARSHIP

Dwight Jacobus was the founder of ASBO MD&DC in 1952 and was also its first Executive Director. The first scholarship in his name was awarded to Janine Good in 1977, who went on to become a Neurologist at the University of Maryland Medical Center. Since then, scholarships have been awarded annually to future prospects in the world of school business management or education as an example of ASBO's commitment to the next generation of education leaders.

Each year, ASBO competitively awards up to eight \$1,000 scholarships to students attending a Maryland or District of Columbia institution of higher education.
