Superintendent's Contract Renewed

The **Board of Education of Dorchester County** is pleased to announce the **renewal of the contract** of **Dr. Henry V. Wagner, Jr.** for another **four year term** as superintendent by a vote of **5–0** at the **February 20** meeting. This second term will run from **July 1, 2014** through **June 30, 2018**.

In conjunction with this action, **President Philip L. Bramble**, **Jr.** noted that Dr. Wagner's contract renewal **terms and compensation** are now **commensurate with the previously established value of the office of superintendent in Dorchester County**. He also **applauded** Dr. Wagner for the **gains** our district has made over the last four years in **achievement**, **graduation rate**, **Advanced Placement participation and pass rate**, **student behavior management**, **scholarships grant acquisition**, **dual enrollment**, **and safe schools**.

He also noted that the Superintendent has **kept his pledge to:**

- Involve the community through his Advisory Council, Community Forum, and Roundtable
- o Communicate with all stakeholders
- Spotlight positive student and staff accomplishments
- Create task forces to foster effective ongoing collaboration
- Secure additional resources for our district

Mr. Bramble also stated that the Superintendent has represented our district ably in local and state venues, such as the County Council, Board of Public Works, MSDE, MABE, ESMEC, PSSAM, etc. He serves on important community boards and organizations, including Salvation Army, United Way, the Dorchester Economic Advisory Council, the Partnership for a Drug Free Dorchester, the Local Management Board, and Rotary. His final observation was that our district processes are characterized by trust, integrity, and stability.

Dr. Wagner's Second Term Priorities

Following the vote to renew his contract, Dr. Wagner thanked the Board of Education, the students and staff of DCPS, and the Dorchester community for all of their support. He pledged to maintain and /or increase the positive momentum in all of the major initiatives highlighted by President Bramble, while focusing on specific innovations/initiatives/issues such as:

- Closing the persisting achievement/opportunity gaps with respect our minority, FARM, and special education populations
- o Fostering a more diverse and competitively compensated workforce
- o Advancing our **state rankings** with respect to prominent indicators of accountability
- Achieving PARCC Assessment readiness through full implementation of the Common Core
 State Standards and by advancing technological capacity
- Expanding **Prekindergarten** opportunities
- Securing the resources for a new North Dorchester High School
- O Addressing projected **enrollment increases** in a proactive manner
- o Expanding the appropriate use of technology into instructional and administrative processes
