My name is Frank Salgado and I am new instructor at the Carpenter Training Center. I offer a new class called Concrete Floating Stairs. I am trying to get information out to contractors who are interested about my class. Concrete Floating Stairs are basically a set of stairs that are framed and poured before there is a floor to frame it to. I was framing stairs this way in the field for several years and the contractors that were involved in those buildings really liked my process. For safety reasons it was beneficial because now it eliminates the need for ladders to get from one floor to the next. As soon as the framing for the concrete deck starts getting put in place, there is a safe way to access that deck. Another reason contractors liked my process is that production went up because all trades are able to access the deck without having to carry tools or materials up a ladder. I would like be able to train as many carpenters as I can, because I think it is something that should be done whenever possible for both safety and production reasons. I can offer training at our facility for any contractor that is interested. All a contractor would have to do is identify 4-6 individuals that are working for their company and might have the aptitude for this work. I can schedule classes on evenings and weekends at any time. The class is free for any union carpenter. Any Contractor who is interested should contact me asap.
