SUBJECT: 2016 National AGC Safety Awards (NASA)

The National AGC Safety Awards (NASA) program has been an ongoing effort since 1991 to offer AGC members an opportunity to evaluate their safety record. NASA compares an AGC member's safety record with other AGC members according to the member size and construction type. Additionally, NASA provides a great opportunity for contractor members who have excellent safety records to compete for nationally recognized awards.

Eligibility: AGC contractor members must have participated in the National AGC Safety Awards Program for three consecutive years in order to be eligible for an award. This means a member must have participated in the program for the years **2014**, **2015** and **2016** in order to be eligible to receive an award in 2016. Even if you do not meet this "three-year" criteria currently, I strongly urge you to submit your company's information so that you may begin the eligibility process for future awards.

AGC contractors **with direct-hire**, **job-site craft labor** are eligible to compete in *one or more* of the following categories:

BuildingFederal & HeavyHighwayMunicipal/Utilities

- Associate/Specialty

<u>How to Enter</u>: General contractor and subcontractor members must submit their entries directly to the Builders Association. We will then forward final data to AGC of America on behalf of our firms. <u>Deadline to forward the attached Entry Form to us is Wednesday</u>, February 8, 2017.

Certificates of Commendation are given to AGC members who have a zero incident rate or who have an incident rate 25% below each occupational division's average.

<u>Award Distribution</u>: We will notify you in April of results and will confer all AGC awards during our Spring Summit on Thursday, May 11, 2016 at Maggiano's Oak Brook. *Please note the annual Builders Association Safety Awards will be distributed at this time as well; further information on that Safety Awards Program will be disseminated to our members shortly.*
