

Required Action for ENERGY STAR Certification

Your building may be eligible for ENERGY STAR certification for FREE through the Kilowatt Crackdown.

However, because of recent changes to Portfolio Manager, you may need to adjust default values in order to proceed. If your building has a default value for the Parking Supplemental Heating Option, you may need to change this setting. Please follow the instructions below to ensure your building's eligibility:

Required actions:

- Change the "Share" permissions setting to provide Full Access to BOMA-PDX (Jack Davis).
- Update energy meter information through the present month.
- Review your Scoping Study and address any comments related to ENERGY STAR eligibility.
- Under the Details tab, verify that each space use has no "default values." Where default values are present, as shown in the image below, change them to actual values by clicking the dropdown "I want to...Correct Mistakes."
 - NOTE: A common issue occurs with Parking spaces where the Supplemental Heating value may be listed as "Default." Correct the default value to be "yes" or "no," as appropriate.



You will know if your building is eligible for certification if the Current Score is 75 or higher and you

see the "Apply" button as shown below.
