Air Compliance Auditing for Industrial Facilities

October 12 - San Diego, CA

This 1-day course is for industrial corporate and facility environmental personnel responsible for air permitting and compliance audits. The course covers general auditing concepts and practices, a brief overview of air regulations and permitting requirements, how to prepare and complete an air compliance audit, and documenting and handling audit findings. The course includes a review of example audit work documents, dissection of an air permit for auditing purposes, and group exercises.

Air Quality Permitting in California - South Coast

October 18 - Irvine, CA


This intensive 1-day course is intended for environmental professionals responsible for air quality permitting and compliance management for their facilities. Each course is focused on state and/or district requirements for the location of the course. A brief overview of federal requirements and detailed information on state/local regulations provide the information needed to prepare or manage the air permit application process for new or modified sources. Common reporting and compliance management tasks are reviewed, and recent and ongoing regulatory developments are discussed.

Introduction to Environmental Reporting in California

October 19 - Irvine, CA

This 1-day course is designed for professionals responsible for California environmental reporting who would benefit from learning California specific environmental media and associated regulatory requirements.
