After a triple-stacked tank mine detonated below his vehicle in Al Anbar Province, Iraq in 2004, Jake suffered compound fractures in his left leg and left arm; multiple skin, ligament and bone losses; varying burns; partial loss of his left hand and arm; amputation below the knee of his right leg, traumatic brain injury (TBI) and post traumatic stress disorder (PTSD).


Jake has undergone 46 operations, 23 blood transfusions, and countless hours of rehabilitation. A passionate and fearless leader whose quick wit and stories of intestinal fortitude have a profound impact on everyone he meets, Jake has appeared on James Gandolfini's HBO special "Alive Day Memories: Home from Iraq," as well as "60 Minute Sports," and various other local and national venues. Jake also plays a small role in Clint Eastwood's production of "American Sniper." You can read Jake's open letter to warriors and his eloquent wisdom on resilience in Psychology Today. Jake has dedicated himself to the 22KILL mission and is a key part in their success.

JEFF KYLE

Jeff Kyle, a veteran of the U.S. Marine Corps, served eight years from 2000-2008 as an infantryman and with Reconnaissance. Kyle deployed three times, twice to Iraq and once to Africa. During his time in the service, Sgt. Kyle instructed numerous Marines, Australians, Koreans and many other allied forces on marksmanship. Jeff dealt with the loss of many friends during the war and even more after leaving the military. The suicide rate was rampant in the veteran community, and he didn't want to fall into that web. After seeking help from organizations outside the military and VA, he fought to stop the epidemic and co-founded with his immediate family the American Valor Foundation. The foundation assists veterans, as well as first responders. Jeff understands the struggles of civilian life and the loss of brothers. He also stays close to our warriors by designing and building quality gear that is focused on our warriors' needs on the front lines.

Jeff has been an ambassador with 22KILL from the beginning, helping with the mission to stop veteran suicide.

TIMOTHY L. KELLNER



Timothy L. Kellner is a dedicated and committed asset to the military and international sniper community during the global war on terrorism. Kellner was recognized as one of the top snipers in world history when he was the guest speaker at the 9th International Sniper Competition at Ft. Benning. Timothy served as an infantryman, but most of his career was spent dedicated to Reconnaissance, Surveillance, and Long Range Target interdiction. He has multiple combat deployments, and has used these experiences to help develop sniper programs within the U.S. Army during his career.

Kellner was severely injured in Iraq by an IED that flipped a HMMWV that he was traveling in. Less than 2 years later, he returned to combat in the same area of Iraq. Kellner's military training includes Long Range Marksman, SERE-C, Sniper Employment Leaders Course, Sniper, Long Range Surveillance Leaders Course, Basic Man-Tracking, Jumpmaster, and SPIES/FRIES Master.

Since retirement, Tim continues to teach and train both LE and military. He assists in refining SOPs and the development of training courses. Timothy has been featured and mentioned in several books such as, "Kill Shot: 15 Deadliest Snipers of All Time," "Modern Snipers," "SAS and Elite Guide Sniper," "Sniper: Single shot Warriors," "Modern American Snipers," and "Confirmed Kill."

Tim is very active in 22KILL, teaching shooting skills and creating camaraderie events with the camp Valhalla program.
