NAAEI was recently approved by the Military Spouse Career Advancement Account (MyCAA) to provide spouse educational assistance for career training.

The MyCAA Program is a career development and employment assistance program sponsored by the Department of Defense. MyCAA helps military spouses pursue a license, certificate, certification or Associate's Degree necessary for gainful employment in a high-demand, high-growth, portable career field and occupation.

MyCAA provides a maximum education benefit of \$4,000 with an annual fiscal year cap of \$2,000 to assist eligible military spouses in acquiring a professional credential needed to meet their Portable Career goal. Visit www.naahq.org/education/pages/military.aspx.
