What is the Executive Bachelor of Business Administration Program?

The University of Winnipeg's Faculty of Business and Economics offers a unique cohort program for working professionals to complete an Executive 3 year Bachelor of Business Administration degree (eBBA). The program design allows students to work full-time while completing their studies part-time, with courses offered in the evenings and online.

The program is designed for students who have a minimum of five years management experience and a post-secondary education certificate or diploma. Students will be eligible for transfer credit for the academic courses taken and up to 15 credit hours of Recognized Prior Learning credit.

Who should Enroll for this Program?

- Students meeting the admission requirements: minimum of 5 years management experience and post-secondary education certificate/diploma
- Students seeking a program designed with flexible course delivery that provides the ability to work full-time
- Students interested in joining a cohort of other working professionals from a variety of industries across Manitoba
- Students seeking the credential of a bachelors degree to progress in their careers
- Students who have the commitment and support from their employers

Beyond the Classroom

Cohort Program Schedule:

The cohort degree will take between 3 to 4 years to complete.

Courses run

Fall Term September – December

Winter Term January – April

Spring Term May – June/July

Students can expect to take two courses per term from September – April, one course from May – June/July.

Recognized Prior Learning Assessment

The RPL Assessment is done through the completion of a Competency Based Portfolio which captures the non-traditional work experience that can not be counted towards the academic transfer credit received.
