Driving Directions from Saskatoon

- 1. Get on to the Yellowhead Highway (Highway 16) going east and follow it to the Town of Lanigan.
- 2. Proceed 8 km. (5 miles) east, southeast past Lanigan on the Yellowhead Highway (Highway 16).
- 3. Turn north and travel for 3 1/2 km. (2 miles).
- 4. Turn east and travel for 1 km. (3/4 of a mile), the Termuende Ranch is on the right. (You will see a round barn on the ranch site)
- 5. Parking areas for the media will be identified at the site.
