

## CTMA MISSION TO EMO Hannover 2011

The Canadian Tooling and Machining Association (CTMA) and EMO organizers, have extended an invitation through Manitoba Trade and Investment to any interested Manitoba firms to participate in a mission to attend EMO Hannover 2011 (Germany), September 19-24, 2011.

EMO 2011 is the world's largest metalworking & machine tools trade fair and is being held for 6 days from Monday, September 19<sup>th</sup> to Saturday, September 24<sup>th</sup>, 2011 at the Fairgrounds (Messegelände) in Hanover. The trade show is organized by VDW, German Machine Tool Builders' Association. In 2007, the event attracted over 2100 exhibitors from 42 countries in 2007 (over 60% from outside Germany). Over 166,000 visitors from 80 countries attended, of which 1,200 were from Canada.
