

The Exploring India conference will feature experts who will discuss the "ins and outs" of trading with India, inculding investments, potential opportunities, challenges, immigration requirements and more. As Saskatchewan is often the largest contributor to Indo-Canadian trade, this is a must attend event for anyone interested in the opportunities available in India.
