## Course Description

The National Infrastructure Protection Plan identified electric power systems as critical infrastructure (CI). The interdependencies between the electric and other CI sectors, necessitate a common understanding by electric system stakeholders of the electric sector impacts and ways to improve resiliency.

Participants will learn to prepare for, protect against, respond to, recover from, or mitigate against threatened or actual natural disasters, acts of terrorism, or other man-made disasters affecting electric power facilities and systems. Participants will be guided through discussions and exercise that will assist them in improving security against physical damage, organizational disruption, and control system vulnerability.

Participants successfully completing this course will receive a course certificate of completion. Individuals who complete this course in combination with MGT317, MGT341 and MGT343 are eligible for the TEEX Infrastructure Disaster Management Program Certificate.
