### Day 1: Local, state, federal rules & regulations

Introduction to 3 day course: Discussion & Q&A regarding newly adopted rules, general agency how -to's, working and communicating responsibly with the TSBPE as an RMP. Guest lecturers in applicable subject matter relating to governmental agencies (TWC, Comptroller's Office, IRS): insurance, bonds, workman's compensation, small business overview, sales tax.

## Day 2: Finance

"Understanding Overhead": general accounting software, invoicing and inventory, payroll, budgeting, operational loans, credit. Group project: exploring the Small Business Association Online. Importance of online communication when locating finance resources.

## Day 3: Legal, OSHA, Customer Service

Overview: local, state and national legal resources available for new business owners and exploration of legal resource websites and agency descriptions; legal definitions—comprehensive study and take-home guide; Understanding OSHA as the RMP, "Tools of the Trade", "Executing Exceptional Service Calls-a Guideline."
