Ages 1-4 are significant in your child's development. At this age, they become more active and curious. And water, with its sparkling surface & unique qualities, often attracts the attention of little ones.

Water activity is important to a child's mental and physical development, so let's review some important safety tips!

But sadly, according to the CDC, drowning is the No. 1 cause of injury-related deaths for children ages 1-4. Therefore, the PSA highlights important water safety tips to protect this vulnerable age group.
