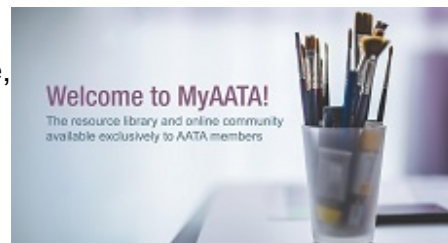

Editor in Chief Sought for *Art Therapy: Journal of the American Art Therapy Association*



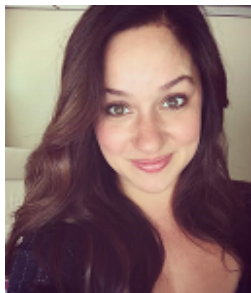
