

Don Brady Director of EFED

Don Brady has been the Director of the Environmental Fate and Effects Division (EFED) - composed of world class scientists responsible for conducting ecological risk assessments - in EPA's Office of Pesticide Programs since October, 2007. EFED completes risk assessments by analyzing toxicity and fate information for pesticides to determine whether the pesticide is safe for the wildlife and the environment. EFED is also responsible for conducting scientific assessments to determine any impact use of a pesticide may have on endangered species. Don is a long time EPA manager, most recently he served as Chief of the Municipal Branch in EPAs Water Permits Division where he was responsible for managing wet-weather permitting programs under section 402 of the Clean Water Act. Prior to that, he served for ten years as Chief of the Watershed Branch, Assessment and Watershed Protection Division, in EPAs Office of Wetlands, Oceans and Watersheds where he was responsible for management of the Total Maximum Daily Load (TMDL) program required by section 303(d) of the CWA. He has a BA in Political Science from Fordham University, and both a Masters and Ph.D. in Government from Georgetown University.
