PCOC 2011 INDIVIDUAL MEMBERSHIP CONTEST

CONTEST RULES

The individual who recruits the most new Regular, Supplemental, General and/or Affiliate members between January 1, 2011 and May 31, 2011 will win **\$1000.00**.

In addition, each time a member is recruited a raffle ticket will be issued in the name of the recruiter. A raffle will be held at the Convention in Anaheim with two raffle tickets being pulled and \$500.00 will be awarded to each raffle winner. In order to qualify for a raffle ticket the rules noted below will apply.

Should there be a tie in the number of members recruited, the person who recruits the most Regular Members shall be declared the winner.

 member's STATE DUES only. District dues must be paid in full.

- Recruiting begins January 1, 2011 and will end on May 31, 2011. All applications must be
 postmarked by or received at the PCOC office no later than end of business on May 31,
 2011. NO EXCEPTIONS.

- The winner will be announced in the July 2011 edition of the NewsBriefs.
- MOST IMPORTANTLY: In order to be counted for a new member referral, you (the recruiter) MUST ensure that your name is written in the "Referred by" portion of the PCOC membership application. If you are not identified as the referral person when the application is submitted to the PCOC office, you will not receive credit for the referral. There will be no exceptions to this rule. Please make sure YOUR NAME, not a company name, is written on the application.
