Senator Michael J. Rubio was elected to the 16th State Senate District in November 2010, representing all or portions of Fresno, Kern, Kings and Tulare Counties.

Notably, Senator Rubio is also the youngest Senator currently serving in the California State Senate. Senator Rubio was previously elected in March 2004 to represent the Fifth District on the Kern County Board of Supervisors.

The Senator firmly believes that putting people back to work needs to be the state's first order of business. From restoring water in the San Joaquin Valley to streamlining the permitting process for diverse industries, Senator Rubio recognizes the importance of creating jobs and its connection to a better quality of life for all Californians.
