Work Site FAQs

What will it cost me?

There is no cost to participate in the program. You provide the work environment and training, and we provide pre-screened students.

How long is the commitment?

Internships should provide a minimum of 60 hours in one semester. Contact us for details.

How many hours per week are the students available?

The hours vary by student. We ask a minimum of 4-6 hours are given each week and up to the maximum allowed by law.

What if the students doesn't work out?

Sometimes it happens. Just let us know so we can assist with the transition and help find another student.

What do I teach them?

We expect all worksites to provide basic skills training to help build good work ethics along with any industry-specific skills and training you can offer.

My intern is great, can I hire them?
