

Construction Funding in the Disaster Aid Portion of Bipartisan Budget Act of 2018

The chart below details several—but not all—federal construction accounts that would receive funding under the Bipartisan Budget Act of 2018. The dollars allocated in the accounts below will be used—exclusively or in large measure—on construction services contracts.

The bill includes \$23.5 billion for the Federal Emergency Management Administration’s relief and rebuilding efforts as well as \$28 billion for the Department of Housing and Urban Development’s Community Development Fund. Although there will undoubtedly be construction contracts as a result of those funds, it is unclear how much of those funds will be used directly for construction. As such, those dollars are not included below.
