General Contractor recognized for excellence in Organizational and Young Worker Safety Categories

Walsh Canada Vice President and Business Group Leader, Craig Lesurf, and Health and Safety Manager, Dave Irwin, were called to the stage at the annual gala held on October 24<sup>th</sup> to receive the honours, which include the Silver Award for the Building and Construction category and the Silver Award for Young Worker Safety.

The Building and Construction Silver award recognized Walsh Canada for demonstrating excellence in its overall health and safety program and culture, highlighted by Walsh's outstanding health and safety record, its leadership role in promoting health and safety across the industry through initiatives such as Safety Week, Safety Month, League of Champions, and its efforts of engaging staff at all levels to raise the bar for safety staff through various forms of positive reinforcement.

The Young Worker Silver award was presented to Walsh for its heightened focus on keeping its young workers safe, highlighted by its graduated Yellow Hard Hat program that visually identifies young workers from more experienced workers until a defined set of criteria are achieved, its Young Worker Mentoring Program, and a minimum ratio of experienced to young workers on project sites so that younger workers can be more closely monitored and positively influenced by the established best practices of their peers. Walsh also supported industry-wide young worker initiatives that included MySafeWork and Courageous, while also founding a new annual bursary in 2017 for George Brown College's Construction and Engineering Technologies program named the Walsh Canada Bursary for Safety and Academic Excellence.

"It's a great honour to be recognized among many other prominent construction companies across Canada," says Walsh Canada's Craig Lesurf. "To receive two awards in the same year is a validation of the strong health and safety culture at the Walsh Group and the high level of engagement we have achieved with our staff in our continual pursuit to make sure that everyone goes home safe at the end of each day.
