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Additional Workplace Screening Requirements Now in Force

On February 26, 2021, the Office of the Chief Medical Officer of Health for Ontario updated its <u>COVID-19</u> <u>Screening Tool for Businesses and Organizations (Screening Workers)</u> and its <u>COVID-19 Screening Tool for Businesses and Organizations (Screening Patrons)</u>. Under the <u>Reopening Ontario (A Flexible Response to COVID-19 Act, 2020</u> and its associated <u>regulations</u>, every business or organization to which the screening tools apply must ensure these tools comply with the updated requirements.

To this end, please note **two new screening requirements** specifically related to household members of a worker or patron:

- In regards to travel outside of Canada, a worker or patron must also answer the question, "In the last 14 days, have you **or anyone you live with** travelled outside of Canada?" (emphasis added).
- A new question requires a worker or patron to answer the question, "Is anyone you live with currently experiencing any new COVID-19 symptoms and/or waiting for test results after experiencing symptoms"? If the answer is yes, the worker or patron must be advised to stay home until the sick individual gets a negative COVID-19 test result, is cleared by their local public health unit, or is diagnosed with another illness.
