City of Brampton requiring COR™ in 2021 Implementation

In continuing to build a future-ready organization, Brampton has adopted the Certificate of Recognition (COR™) program as part of its construction contract management and construction tendering process. This is a reaffirmation of the City's ongoing commitment to health and safety for contractors, employees and residents.

The requirement to be COR™ certified has been implemented since January 2019 for construction projects over \$25M. Starting January 2021, the requirement for COR™ will be implemented for construction and maintenance projects between \$5M and \$10M.

The following chart outlines the proposed schedule for implementing COR in future years:

<i>Value of Contract</i>	<i>Proposed Implementation</i>
<i>>\$25M</i>	<i>January 2019 – implemented</i>
<i>\$10M - \$25M</i>	<i>January 2020 – implemented</i>
<i>\$5M - \$10M</i>	<i>January 2021</i>
<i><\$5M</i>	<i>January 2022</i>
