

Dear OBOA Members,

Last week, we notified you that the OBOA was seeking a legal opinion on the Ontario government's amended O.Reg. 82/20 Order made under Subsection 7.0.2 (4) of the *Emergency Management and Civil Protection Act.* This regulation was a further limitation of the businesses/services which are deemed essential.

This legal opinion further interprets how building officials can and should interpret their roles, rights, and levels of service under O.Reg 82/20 from a legal point of view, with a particular focus of how the Reg. and Order interfaces with the Building Code Act and Regulations.
