The Honours Bachelor of Construction Management program provides graduates with the knowledge, skills and abilities required for in-depth construction management in residential, industrial, commercial, and institutional sectors of the construction industry.

Graduates of the program will have a firm grounding in the theory, principles, and practices of construction science as well as the business acumen and leadership to assist in project execution, site planning, and quality assurance processes. Graduates will have the knowledge and skills required to effectively assist with the management of construction projects to successful completion.

The program provides a strong foundation in civil engineering, building construction, and architectural technology and an in-depth study of business management skills. The program emphasizes critical and analytical thinking skills, the importance of interdisciplinary practice, and strong leadership.

It is designed to prepare graduates to pursue certifications including the Certified Associate in Project Management (CAPM), Gold-Seal Certified (GSC), and Construction Estimator Certified (CEC) certifications. In addition, graduates of the program will have the knowledge and skills to pursue further graduate study in Construction Management or related fields.

Graduates will be prepared to successfully gain employment as assistant construction managers, project coordinators, junior estimators, and contract administrators. With additional education and experience, graduates may be considered for roles as project coordinators, assistant project managers, and assistant site superintendents in the construction sector.
