Each can be purchased electronically for just \$199—regardless of length—and published to the Link2Build.ca site where it is archived indefinitely, and meets all stated legal requirements under the *Construction Act*. Additionally, all fees charged for publishing CSPs on Link2Build.ca are returned directly to the seven members of the Link2Build alliance—not-for-profit groups that contribute to the ongoing integrity and professionalism of Ontario's construction industry.
