At this time, the ORCGA has 502 members.

Step 1 – September 20 - November 28, 2018 (completed)

The 2018 Board of Directors (incumbents) whose stakeholder category is up for reelection will be asked to confirm if they would like to continue as the 2019 Board representative for their respective stakeholder group. Board positions up for election due to resignations/retirements etc. to be identified. The replies are to be sent directly to the ORCGA President.

Step 2a - November 28, 2018 (completed)

The names of the stakeholder (incumbents) who will remain on the Board for the coming term starting at the 2019 Symposium and AGM, in addition to the Board positions up for election will be confirmed and approved by the Board.

Step 2b – January 3-11, 2019

The request for nominations for Board positions up for election will be sent to their respective stakeholder group members advising them to submit their names should they be interested in representing their stakeholder group on the Board. The replies are to be sent directly to the ORCGA President.

Step 3 - January 14-24, 2019

The names of the nominated stakeholder candidates will be sent to their respective stakeholder members and the members will be asked to vote for their Board representative. As per the By-Laws, each member will have one vote, and any members who are legal entities (i.e. Corporations) shall designate the person who will vote on their behalf. We need 1/10 of each membership class as a 'quorum' to participate in the voting. The replies are to be sent directly to the ORCGA President.

Please note: If there are <u>no</u> Board candidates names submitted, the 2019 Board member will be recommended and ratified by the Board per the By-laws.

Step 4 – January 25-28, 2019

The candidates will be advised of the election results by January 28, 2019. The names of the 2019 ORCGA Board of Directors will be announced to the membership at the ORCGA Annual General Meeting on February 13, 2019.
