Originally opened in 1972 and renovated in 2002-2004 by Paul Takahashi, Station Creek is an easy-walking parkland course known for mature forests, rolling terrain, its modern practice range and quiet ambience. The course is in Gormley on the northeastern edge of Greater Toronto, minutes from Highway 404.

To warm up or sharpen your game, the practice range has everything you need... a 1.5 acre tee deck, six target greens and a short-game practice area that includes a putting green, chipping green and a bunker.

For a solid test of golf, a quiet escape and an array of terrific amenities, make sure you stop at Station Creek with the ORCGA Golf Tournament on June 27.
