The issues

The issues that have been selected for discussion with members of Congress are issues on which there is broad support within the roofing industry. For Roofing Day in D.C. 2018, we will focus on three issues: regulatory reform, workforce development and immigration reform.

Regulatory reform: The roofing industry supports the Regulatory Accountability Act (RAA), bipartisan legislation (S. 951) aimed to reduce burdensome regulations by reforming the regulatory development process. The RAA is designed to provide more transparency and accountability in the regulatory development process, helping ensure new regulations are less burdensome on employers and economic growth. The roofing industry believes regulatory reform is critical to ensuring excessive regulation does not prevent U.S. employers from growing their businesses and creating jobs.

Workforce development: The roofing industry supports legislation to address the chronic workforce shortages in the industry by improving career and technical education (CTE). The roofing industry supports the Strengthening Career and Technical Education for the 21st Century Act, bipartisan legislation (H.R. 2353) to make CTE programs more responsive to the workforce needs of employers.

Immigration reform: Roofing industry employers provide good jobs for qualified workers but face chronic workforce shortages because of an aging workforce and other demographic trends. Immigration reform is vital to addressing future workforce needs of the roofing industry, and sensible reforms should end illegal immigration without encouraging a black market economy. The roofing industry supports immigration reforms that include increased border security, improved workplace enforcement, providing for temporary workers to enter the U.S. legally when our economy needs them, and addressing the existing unauthorized workforce in a balanced manner.
