

## ATTENTION INSPECTORS: YOUR EXPIRATION DATE HAS CHANGED

As promised and in response to overwhelming feedback from the Inspector community, the TSBPE has rolled out major changes to Inspector license expiration dates. All Inspectors will fall into one of the following two buckets:

If you hold a plumber license in addition to your Inspector License

Your Inspector License's expiration date has been changed to mirror the expiration date of your highest ranking plumbing license

If you <u>do not</u> hold a plumbing license of any kind

Your inspector License's expiration date has been changed to a randomly-selected month.\*

\*the earliest possible expiration date for those Inspectors who do not carry a plumber license is February 2022.

## Here's how to check your new expiration date using our public license search:

- 1. Click <u>here</u> to visit the TSBPE homepage (<u>tsbpe.texas.gov</u>).
- 2. Click "Find a License Registration" located in the gray band at the very top of the page.
- 3. Click the second option from the top, "Search by name for a Specified License Type."
- 4. Select "Texas State Board of Plumbing Examiners" for the Board and then "Plumbing Inspector" for the license type and click "Continue."
- 5. Enter your Last and First name, click the "I'm not a robot" square and click "Search."
- 6. Click your name in the search results to view your profile, your new Expiration Date will be listed in the top section where it says "Expiry Date."
