Accessibility Modification Grants

VHDA has grants for up to \$6,000, which may be used to help people with disabilities make their rental homes more accessible. Landlords are required by fair housing laws to permit modifications to an apartment to make it barrier-free – but tenants usually bear the cost, which can be substantial. That's where a VHDA grant may help!

VHDA currently offers two types of accessibility grants:

- Rental Unit Accessibility Modification Grant (RUAM) provides funds to make rental housing more accessible. For details and eligibility requirements, visit vhda.com/RUAM.
