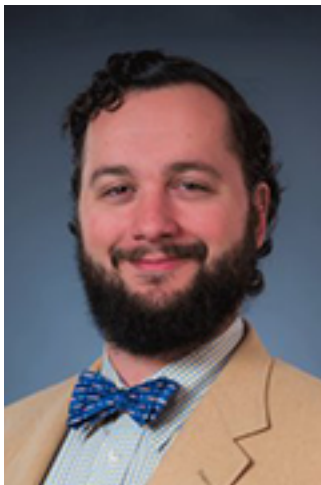
brings extensive experience with HUD's Housing Choice Voucher program to VAMA.
