On May 1st 2015, my wife and I lost our youngest Son, Cole Gaudry, to a drug overdose. Cole was an energetic, full of life 19-year-old, who was working in the Building Industry. He was not an addict, but was, as most 19-year-olds, very daring, and truly thought he was invincible. Cole passed away from taking one pill of the drug Fentanyl.

We know that drugs are not just a street level problem, but are very prevalent in all classes of today's society. And because of the unfortunately common stories we hear, we were moved to take action and are proud to promote a fundraising Motorcycle Ride to bring Drug Awareness to Parents and Children.
